

CHAMBER LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL FIRST FRIDAY IN SEPTEMBER

PURPOSE

Leadership Shelby County was created to increase the quality and quantity of men and women capable of accepting leadership roles in varied community organizations. Participants are exposed to a variety of social and economic issues facing our area. This awareness helps develop informed, civic-oriented leaders who are interested in helping direct the future of Shelby County.

PROGRAM

The Chamber Leadership Program consists of 10 sessions (mostly full day, a couple of ½ day sessions) held one day a month from September through June, typically the third Thursday of each month. The sessions are held at various locations in Shelby County that best relate to the topic. During each session, participants are introduced to issues by means of panels, lectures, tours, group discussions and simulations. In each case, the program is designed to address specific areas rather than vague concepts.

PARTICIPANTS

Participants are selected in an objective process with information presented on a completed program application. Selection criteria are:

- Motivation and commitment to serve the community
- Demonstrated leadership qualities
- An interest in participating in community projects upon completion of the series

NOTE: The maximum capacity for each year's class is 25. Participants are required to attend the **entire day of all sessions** to graduate. Missed sessions must be made up within two years after the initial program year.

As part of the program, participants serve an internship with a local non-profit or governmental group. Selection and placement are made after the first Leadership session in September. Those currently serving on an active board may submit a written request (email) to be excused from the internship requirement.

The topics covered in the Leadership program are: Leadership Development; Local History and Geography; Economic Development; Law Enforcement, Fire & Rescue; Education; Human Services; Media; Health Services; Local Government; Agriculture.

TUITION

If accepted in the Leadership Shelby County program, each participant (or participant's sponsor or company) will be billed for the tuition fee of \$300.00 for program costs. There is partial financial assistance available in applicable situations.

INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENT
Participants are required to serve a three-meeting internship as a non-voting member of a local community service, non-profit board. This internship will be served concurrent with the Chamber Leadership Program year from September through June. If chosen to be a Participant, you will be given an opportunity to pick your first, second and third internship choices from a supplied list of available boards. You will also be given dates and times of regular board meetings so your selection can appropriately fit your schedule. You may be excused from the internship requirement if you are actively serving on a non-profit or governmental board, council or commission. Requests to be excused must be submitted to the Chamber Vice President prior to the September session.
APPLICATION DEADLINE
Applications must be received at the Sidney-Shelby County Chamber of Commerce by the first Friday in September. Maximum participant number is 25. Applicants will be notified of acceptance or non-acceptance by the following Monday.
All applications are subject to confidential evaluations by the Chamber of Commerce Vice President, President and Board of Directors.
